# Relocation of the South 69kv Line Project Bid

Jeff Winders presented the bid results for the South 69kv line relocation. There were 3 bids received. Fisher Arnold evaluated the bids and provided a letter of recommendation. This letter included a recommendation that BMU accept the low bid of \$2,581,885.56 from JF Electric and that BMU execute the acceptance form as soon as possible so that the construction to begin on schedule. After some discussion on the project, a motion to award the bid to JF Electric was made by Steve Burch and was seconded by Brian Menz. A roll call vote was held, all yes. The bid was awarded to JF Electric.

# **Wastewater Plant Update**

BMU Staff members discussed current issues involving the South Wastewater Treatment Plant. In reference to the 11/18/21 Waters Engineering Report on the of the wastewater system, recent circumstances have caused the need for portions of the Phase 1 recommendations from the report to be addressed immediately. There was some discussion about immediate steps needed, the most urgent items to address, and possible funding sources. Staff will provide more information in the Board's regular April meeting.
